GREY WINE

Grey wine is the name given to very pale rosés made from gentle, direct pressing. No skin maceration takes place, so tannin and color extraction is minimal. This yields an expressive and delicate free-run must that anticipates great complexity.

RED GRENACHE

In pale rosés, Grenache is known for bringing fruity and floral character. The resulting wines are elegant and subtle, with good acidity provided the chosen vineyard allows for it.

ELABORATION

The harvest is carried out manually to preserve the integrity of the grapes as much as possible and to avoid excessive color extraction. Once in the winery, the grapes are chilled to preserve the most delicate aromas and gently pressed. Unlike the usual pressing yield, which can reach up to 65%, we extract only 40% of the juice, thus reserving the purest and most elegant fraction of the grapes.

Fermentation takes place in stainless steel tanks at controlled temperature to preserve the primary aromas and capture all their aromatic richness. Once fermented, the wine rests on its lees, adding greater complexity, volume, and depth on the palate.

SENSATIONS

Appearance: Very pale rosé with distinctive greyish hues that give it its name.

Aromas: Intense and fragrant. Fresh floral aromas (rose and jasmine) and citrus (mandarin and orange). Spicy hints.

Palate: Elegant with notes of red and white fruits, creamy texture and persistent acidity. Saline touches.

Particularity: Aromas characteristic of both white and red wines, giving it a unique personality. Very refreshing citrus notes, unusual for a Mediterranean rosé. A fusion of fermentative aromas (red fruit) and thiolic ones (tropical).

PAIRING

Ideal as an aperitif or to accompany delicate rice dishes and seafood or fish recipes.
