TASTING NOTES

Wine of intense red color. The nose is dominated by ripe black fruits, accompanied by light hints of cooking herbs and toasted notes from its time in oak. The palate is full-bodied, with silky tannins and a long, pleasant finish.

Pair with red meats and mature cheeses.

10 months in French and American oak.
